It takes place in Iraq in 2003 right at the beginning of Operation Iraqi Freedom, and the main character is the Civil Affairs Battalion. Ethan Hartford's (8A) uncle (Scott Spaulding) was in the Civil Affairs Battalion, and he came in to speak to the class about his time there. He joined the Marine Corps in 2003, served multiple deployments overseas, was a trainer for Civil Affairs when he returned stateside, and left active duty after 12 years as a Staff Sergeant.
