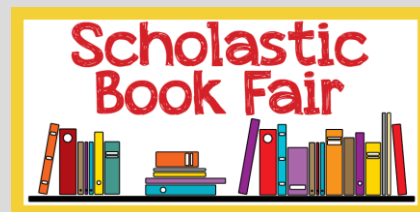

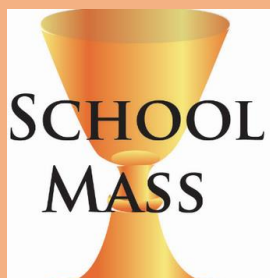

The IDENT-A-KID Child Safety Program will be at our school on March 15 to PHOTOGRAPH, FINGERPRINT, WEIGH and MEASURE children. Parents will receive an ID card (recognized by the U.S. Government's SSA as a form of identification). ID cards are often needed for sports registration, travel, student discounts, and in emergencies.

To participate, please fill in the Application Envelope, which will come home with your child, and have your child return it to school. Applications are also available on line at www.identakid.com. It is recommended that each parent keep a card with them at all times. Additional cards should be given to anyone who regularly cares for your child.

The cost per child is \$10 for one card, \$15 for two cards, \$18 for three cards, and \$20 for four cards (all include eKid-ID). An eKid ID is the electronic Ident-A-Kid card sent to your cell phone via text/picture message and is free when ordering multiple cards. LENTEN REFLECTION

Facing Temptation

Is temptation good? Certainly it's not a sin to be tempted. Otherwise our Lord could never have been tempted Himself. But He was. And so are we. As we enter into the first full week of Lent, we are given the opportunity to ponder the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert.

Temptation is never from God. But God does permit us to be tempted. Not so that we fall, but so that we grow in holiness. Temptation forces us to rise up and make a choice either for God or for the temptation. Though mercy and forgiveness are always offered when we fail, the blessings that await those who overcome temptation are numerous. Jesus' temptation did not increase His holiness, but it did afford Him the opportunity to manifest His perfection within His human nature.

It is that perfection we seek and His perfection that we must strive to imitate as we face the temptations of life. Let's look at five clear "blessings" that can come from enduring the temptations of the evil one. Ponder these carefully and slowly:

First, enduring a temptation and conquering it helps us see the strength of God in our lives.

Second, temptation humbles us, stripping away our pride and our struggle of thinking we are self-reliant and self-made.

Third, there is great value in completely rejecting the devil. This not only robs him of his ongoing power to deceive us, but it also clarifies our vision of who he is so that we can continue to reject him and his works.

Fourth, overcoming temptation clearly and definitively strengthens us in every virtue.

Fifth, the devil would not tempt us if he were not concerned about our holiness. Thus, we should see temptation as a sign that the evil one is losing hold of our lives.

We should take great joy in overcoming temptation in our lives, realizing that this strengthens us to the core of our being. As we do so, we must also do so in humility, realizing that we have not accomplished this on our own but only by the grace of God in our lives. Reflect, today, upon Jesus facing the devil in the desert after spending 40 days of fasting. He faced every temptation of the evil one so as to assure us that if we but unite ourselves completely to Him in His human nature, so we also will have His strength to overcome anything and everything the vile devil throws our way.



The Church begins the second phase of Lent—an extended meditation on Baptism—with one of the key gospel passages that were taught to the catechumens of the early Church as they

prepared to receive the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil: Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist.

Today's story of Jesus and the Samaritan woman, the longest dialogue in the four gospels, is such an important moment in the Forty Days that, although other

gospel passages are appointed for this Sunday in years B and C of the Lectionary cycle, the

Church asks that, in those years, this Gospel of "living water" be read on one weekday of the

following week. Those who will be called to renew their baptismal promises at the Easter Vigil, as

well as those being baptized or received into the full communion of the Catholic Church, are being

addressed by the Lord in a special way today through his dialogue with the foreigner from whom he asks a drink of water: a conversation that teaches the entire Church something very important about prayer.

Artesanos Don Bosco is one project in a long list of volunteer-run charitable works of the organization called Operation Mato Grosso (OMG).

Father Ugo De Censi is a Catholic priest belonging to the Salesian Congregation. A faithful devotee of St. John Bosco, he loves to work with the youth. In 1967 he founded OMG, a movement created to help people in poverty.

Operation Mato Grosso started off as an adventurous trip with the idea to help others. In 1966, Fr. Ugo asked a group of young Italians to travel to Brazil for the summer to help his missionary friend, Fr. Pietro, build a school and health post. By July of the next year, 21 young people left for the Brazilian state of Mato Grosso. After four months of work, they were not able to complete the building, and some decided to stay. Those who returned to Italy started to raise money to support the mission. The mission now includes 110 different communities across Brazil, Bolivia, Ecuador, and Peru.

DURING THIS **LENT** KEEP IN MIND PEOPLE IN NEED



Since 2017, every year from January to mid-April, we run our Annual Food Drive. The objective is to fill as many shipping containers as possible and ship them to our missions in Peru. We collect six staple food items (pasta, sugar, rice, flour, canned food, and cooking oil). We started with one small container (20 feet long) the first time, and every year we got better. In 2022 we shipped 4 containers (40 feet long).

This year will be our 7th Annual Food Drive. As mentioned before, since 2017, we have always doubled the amount of food collected, and once again, we're not looking to match it; we aim to double the amount!

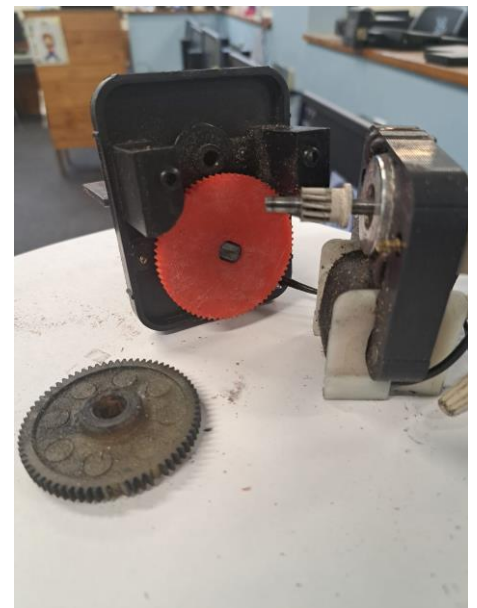




In Science class, our 8th grade students explored the power of hydraulics.
