Our Catholic Faith at St. Philip Neri School




"The Rosary is the most excellent form of prayer and the most efficacious means of attaining eternal life. It is the remedy for all our evils, the root of all our blessings. There is no more excellent way of praying." - Saint Pope Leo XIII.

For centuries, the Catholic Church has set aside the entire month of May to honor Mary, Mother of God. Not just a day in May, mind you, but the entire month. The custom spans both centuries and cultures, with roots going back as far as the Ancient Greeks.

Catholics do not pray to Mary as if she were God. Prayer to Mary focuses on the great mysteries of our faith (The Incarnation, Redemption through Christ), praise to God for the wonderful things he has done in and through one of his creatures ("Hail Mary") and intercession (second half of the Hail Mary).

Why do Catholics say Hail Mary?

Origin. The Hail Mary is rooted in Scripture — the initial lines are taken directly from the first chapter of the Gospel of Luke. We read that God sends the Angel Gabriel to proclaim to the Virgin Mary that she is to bear the Son of God. Upon coming to her, the Angel greets Mary, saying, "Hail, full of grace!





May is the month when Catholics show their devotion to Our Lady, Jesus' blessed mother. We pray the Rosary using beads to count how many prayers have been said. Pope Francis asks that we pray the rosary to ask Our Lady to intercede for us during these difficult times.


