SPN School Instrumental Music Program

Instrumental Music for America is an "On School Time" educational teaching program designed to give young students in grades 4-8 the best possible opportunity to learn to play a band instrument.

The program employs only those highly-qualified teachers who have earned college degrees in the field of instrumental music. This program operates as follows:

Students will receive one class lesson per week in groups of like instruments. These lessons will be 30 minutes long. All students in Advance Band are required to participate in the weekly scheduled after-school band practice. The payments for these lessons are billed directly to the home. Students, when enrolling, may obtain an instrument through the program's rental plan. After school band classes will be held for Advanced Band members.

A Band Demo is scheduled for our school on Friday, September 8 at 8:30 AM.



- Provide <u>all</u> the information requested on the screen. Several fields are required, including: First & Last Name, Email Address, Home Address, City, State, Zip, Phone Number, and Date of Birth. (Note: Do not click the back button or your registration will be lost.) Click Continue to proceed.
- Select the <u>PRIMARY</u> location where you work or volunteer by clicking the downward arrow and highlighting the location. Click Continue to proceed.
- 4) Your selected location(s) are displayed on the screen.

Select <u>YES</u> if you need to add secondary/additional locations. (Follow instructions in previous step to select additional locations.)

Otherwise, if your list of locations is complete, select NO.

- 5) Select the role "Volunteer with Substantial Contact with Children" that you serve within the Archdiocese of Baltimore and/or parish/school. (Use descriptions supplied to help determine appropriate role(s) to select.) Please check <u>all</u> roles that apply. Click Continue to proceed.

A driving record check is required for Church Personnel at a Covered Entity when driving others is an explicit requirement of their employment or volunteer duties or operating a vehicle owned or leased by a Covered Entity and/or the Archdiocese. - Please submit three references. Click on Save to continue.
- Please select the online session you wish to complete. Click on Complete Registration to continue.
- 12) Click on Complete ESR Background Check to be directed to the ESR background check secure website. Please complete the steps within the background check process, for which you will need your Social Security Number or Tax ID number and your current and prior full residential addresses for the past seven years where you lived, worked, or studied. Once you submit your consent form in ESR, you will proceed to enter your information for the background screening. Once you close the ESRCheck screen, you will be taken automatically to the online training course.
- Click on the green circle to begin the Online Training.
