The annual St. Philip Neri School Fall Festival is fast approaching. Each year the students enjoy games, wheels, fun and prizes. They also get to order pizza from Papa Johns, which must be pre-ordered on the attached form by Thursday, November 9. NO EXCEPTIONS. We must have a full count the weekend before the Fall Festival to contact Papa Johns to order. We will not be able to take ticket or lunch orders after Thursday, November 9.

The festival will be 1 day. Papa Johns pizza lunch will be served on Friday 11/17 to the entire school for anyone who orders.

The class schedule for attending will be as follows:

Pre-K & Kindergarten: 8:30am - 9:30am 4th & 5th Grades: 9:45am - 11:00am 1st , 2nd , & 3rd Grades: 11:15am - 12:30am 6th , 7th, & 8th Grades: 1:00pm - 2:30pm

All students will eat lunch in their classrooms. Students can wear an SPN spirit shirt and jeans or sweatpants. Please bring a bag or backpack to carry your prizes and tickets.

Our two most popular wheels are the Treat Wheel and the Snack Wheel. In order for these games to be so successful, we rely on the generosity of our parents.

Treat Wheel:

This year treats can be store-bought and prepackaged OR homemade! Examples of store-bought include: Family size boxes of mini muffins, Hostess cakes, Little Debbie cakes, prepackaged cookies, cakes, etc. Families will receive one volunteer hour for every 2 large size boxes/containers of store bought/prepackaged treats. Families will receive two volunteer hours for every 1 homemade treat (full size cakes/full batch (2 dozen) of cookies/full batch of brownies, etc.). Please send in all store-bought treats by Thursday, November 16th. Store-bought treats can be dropped off earlier in the week. Homemade treats can be brought the day before (Thurs. 11/16) or the day of the festival. Sign in at the school office to get your credit when you drop off the treats. All treats must be labeled with your child's name, parent/guardian name and homeroom in order to get volunteer hours credit. Please also label for the "Fall Festival" so the treats do not get mixed up with the Raffingo donations. The students really LOVE winning at this wheel. Please help make this a success! Thank you!

Snack Wheel:We are asking that each child send in the following items to the school office:

Online Psychoeducational Group for Girls from Divorced/Separated Families (ages 11 & older) Fall 2023

Does your pre-teen or teenage daughter need guidance and support for exploring and expressing her feelings and concerns involving your divorce or separation or the changes following it? Would she like to build connections with other girls in similar family situations?

Does she need to learn skills for coping with stress and communicating effectively? Is she open to discussing faith as part of the healing solution? Would you like suggestions for continuing the conversations with her at home?

Would both you and her other parent give consent for her participation in the group? (Consent forms must be signed by both parents.)

If you answered "yes" to the above questions, contact the Group Facilitator, Lynn Kapusinski, LCPC, NCC (Lynn@FaithJourneys.org) to discuss whether a group program may be appropriate.

The group will meet for 8 weeks. Sessions will be held via Zoom either on Wednesdays at 7 pm or Saturdays at 2 pm. A specific start date and times will be based upon registration needs.

Curriculum will be drawn from the book, "Now What Do I Do? A Guide to Help Teenagers with Their Parents' Separation or Divorce." Winner of a Catholic Press Association book award and the prestigious Mom's Choice Gold Award ®. Purchase of the book is recommended, but not required.

Group size will be limited, so inquire soon!
