Anyone requesting financial aid from the AOB, SPN Parish or School:

Families must complete the FACTS Financial Aid Application found at the link below. A NEW application must be submitted every year if you would like to be considered for aid. This application must be completed and all required documentation submitted by February 29, 2024, to be eligible for any AOB, School, or Parish assistance. The cost to complete this application is \$34. Here is the SPN direct link: https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3QGNP

Log into your account or choose "New Account" to create your account and begin the application process. Questions regarding the application process can be directed to FACTS at 866-441-4637.

Please note that FACTS only processes the applications. The decisions for granting or denying requests for assistance are made separately by: the Archdiocese of Baltimore, St. Philip Neri Parish, and St. Philip Neri School. These decisions are made during the March-April time frame. Applicants will receive a response in May.

ALL TUITION ASSISTANCE AWARDS ARE CONTINGENT UPON SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED FACTS APPLICATION AND SUBMISSION OF PROPER DOCUMENTATION.

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST HAVE A "VERIFIED" STATUS BEFORE ANY ASSISTANCE IS GRANTED.

WHAT IS THE FALL FESTIVAL?

WHAT IS SANTA'S SECRET WORKSHOP?

Santa's Secret Workshop is a long-standing tradition at SPN! This annual event, hosted by the Home and School Association, is a student and parent favorite!

The parish hall at St. Philip Neri is transformed into a Christmas wonderland for our community and parish! Boxes filled with great gifts are delivered throughout the year for this event. Santa's Secret Workshop provides the opportunity for children to shop for nice, inexpensive gifts for their loved ones. The cost of the gifts ranges from \$1 to \$15 and will be wrapped by Santa's little helpers.

Students have 30 minutes to shop and 30 minutes to get their items wrapped. They also receive a special treat this day! Students should bring a list of family members' names that they want to buy presents for. If a student brings in \$20 or more, we ask them to exchange that amount for smaller bills with the HSA Treasurer to make the shopping process a little easier on our sellers.

It takes a tremendous amount of volunteers to pull off this event. The hall is set up the day prior and requires many of Santa's little elves to transform the hall! On SSW day we need over 25 sellers and 25 wrappers throughout the day.

Online Psychoeducational Group for Girls from Divorced/Separated Families (ages 11 & older) Fall 2023

Does your pre-teen or teenage daughter need guidance and support for exploring and expressing her feelings and concerns involving your divorce or separation or the changes following it? Would she like to build connections with other girls in similar family situations?

Does she need to learn skills for coping with stress and communicating effectively? Is she open to discussing faith as part of the healing solution? Would you like suggestions for continuing the conversations with her at home?

Would both you and her other parent give consent for her participation in the group? (Consent forms must be signed by both parents.)

If you answered "yes" to the above questions, contact the Group Facilitator, Lynn Kapusinski, LCPC, NCC (Lynn@FaithJourneys.org) to discuss whether a group program may be appropriate.

The group will meet for 8 weeks. Sessions will be held via Zoom either on Wednesdays at 7 pm or Saturdays at 2 pm. A specific start date and times will be based upon registration needs.

Curriculum will be drawn from the book, "Now What Do I Do? A Guide to Help Teenagers with Their Parents' Separation or Divorce." Winner of a Catholic Press Association book award and the prestigious Mom's Choice Gold Award ®. Purchase of the book is recommended, but not required.

Group size will be limited, so inquire soon!
