Anyone requesting financial aid from the AOB, SPN Parish or School:

Families must complete the FACTS Financial Aid Application found at the link below. A NEW application must be submitted every year if you would like to be considered for aid. This application must be completed and all required documentation submitted by February 29, 2024, to be eligible for any AOB, School, or Parish assistance. The cost to complete this application is \$34. Here is the SPN direct link: https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3QGNP

Log into your account or choose "New Account" to create your account and begin the application process. Questions regarding the application process can be directed to FACTS at 866-441-4637.

Please note that FACTS only processes the applications. The decisions for granting or denying requests for assistance are made separately by: the Archdiocese of Baltimore, St. Philip Neri Parish, and St. Philip Neri School. These decisions are made during the March-April time frame. Applicants will receive a response in April-May.

ALL TUITION ASSISTANCE AWARDS ARE CONTINGENT UPON SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED FACTS
APPLICATION AND SUBMISSION OF PROPER DOCUMENTATION.
ALL APPLICATIONS MUST HAVE A "VERIFIED" STATUS BEFORE ANY ASSISTANCE IS GRANTED.

You MUST complete the Grant & Aid application to be eligible for assistance. New restricts have been put into place for the upcoming year. Completing the application and having received aid in the past is NOT a guarantee that you will automatically be granted assistance again for next school year.

GREGORY A. FARNO APPOINTED CHANCELLOR OF EDUCATION FOR THE ARCHDIOCESE OF BALTIMORE

Mr. Farno joins the archdiocese from Truist Financial Corporation, where he served as the Regional President for the Maryland Region until his retirement in September 2023. As the Regional President for the Maryland Region, Mr. Farno skillfully led the commercial operations of Truist Financial Corporation, ensuring the effective delivery of the firm's services to its clients. Prior to his tenure at Truist Financial Corporation, Mr. Farno held various distinguished positions at SunTrust Bank, including president, managing director, and senior vice president.

Mr. Farno is a highly regarded figure within Baltimore's business community, known for his extensive involvement with philanthropic boards and committees throughout the region. We are incredibly fortunate to have Greg as our Chancellor of Education."

Mr. Farno will succeed as the second Chancellor of Education for the Archdiocese of Baltimore, a position established by Archbishop Lori in 2014 to ensure the long-term sustainability of Catholic Schools through enhanced operational efficiency and oversight.

As the Chancellor of Education, Mr. Farno will oversee the business operations of the Catholic school system. His responsibilities will encompass strategic initiatives for the advancement of Catholic schools, including enrollment recruitment and retention, financial stability, and the implementation of effective marketing and communication strategies. Furthermore, he will actively engage in fundraising endeavors, the development of local school boards, and advocacy for public policy.

Dr. Donna Hargens will continue to serve as the Superintendent of Catholic Schools for the archdiocese, a role she has ably held since 2018.

Mr. Farno will assume his new role on January 17, 2024, poised to bring his exceptional leadership and expertise to further strengthen the educational foundation of the Archdiocese of Baltimore.








