



#### WATER BOTTLE REMINDER

A variety of fresh fruit and vegetables are served daily - apples, oranges, grapes, melons, strawberries, carrots, celery, broccoli, cauliflower

In light of some recent activities regarding the use of water bottles, we wanted to take the time to remind everyone of the policy that can be found in our Parent-Student Handbook on pages 48-49. We also ask you to limit the size of the water bottle to no larger than 32 ounces if possible.

#### DRINKING WATER POLICY

100% Fruit Juice served – apple, orange, grape
Milk offering is 1% white milk and NF flavored milk

Students should bring a **non-breakable** bottle filled with water from home. The following guidelines apply:


Water bottles must have a closable lid with a pushup top to prevent spills. Disposable water bottles are not permitted.

Water bottles must be clearly labeled with the student's first and last name in permanent marker

Water bottles must contain water only: NO juice, sports drinks, or energy drinks

Water bottles are to be taken home daily by the student to be washed and refilled for the next school day

#### Dear Parents:

As we plan for the next academic year at St. Philip Neri School, we extend our heartfelt gratitude to you for entrusting us with the education and formation of your children. We are immensely proud of the progress and achievements they have made thus far, and we remain committed to providing them with the highest standards of academic excellence and spiritual growth.

We write to you today to address an important matter regarding tuition expenses and the anticipated rise in tuition for the upcoming academic year. As you know, maintaining the quality of education and ensuring the sustainability of our school's programs and facilities require careful financial planning and resource allocation. Over the past few years, we have diligently managed our budget to balance the increasing costs associated with providing a comprehensive Catholic education while striving to keep tuition rates as affordable as possible for our families.

Tuition and per-pupil costs are not the same. The average state per-pupil cost of educating each child is approximately \$18,000. Despite our best efforts to control expenses, we find it necessary to implement a modest increase of \$200 in tuition for the 2024-2025 school year. This decision was made after careful consideration and consultation with our School Board, taking into account rising operational costs, faculty salaries, facility maintenance, and enhancements to our academic and extracurricular programs.

We understand the financial commitments that families make to prioritize their children's education, and we remain deeply committed to ensuring that a Catholic education at St. Philip Neri remains accessible to all who seek it. Our goal is to foster a community where every child has the opportunity to thrive academically, spiritually, and personally.
