



You can also support our effort by taking one of the **small collection boxes** to collect spare change through Lent and taking it back after Easter.


We collect 6 staple food items:


This will be our 8th Annual Food Drive. Since 2017 each year we have doubled the amount of food collected the previous year. Thanks for your collaboration




Our 3rd grade computer class worked on designing buildings using Tinkercad for a Social Studies project.






Our 8th grade is designing cathedrals in computer class after learning about them in religion class.
















Our Father,




