House Service Projects

SPN House Service Project

Dear SPN Families,

Each trimester, we will take on one community service project. We will collect items, by house, to give to those in need. Items will be counted and house points will be awarded to each participating house. This trimester we are working with Hope for All and the SPN Food Pantry. Both of these organizations are in desperate need of items to help those in need.

HOPE For All is a Christian ministry whose mission is to provide furniture, household items, and clothing to people in our community who are without the financial means to meet their basic needs. Hope for All is a unique resource in our area for those transitioning from homelessness, or just in need of a helping hand. They offer clients the essentials necessary to create a healthy home.

The Pantry at St. Philip Neri is committed to sharing the love of Jesus by feeding the hungry as set forth in the first Corporal Work of Mercy. The pantry serves 60 households experiencing food insecurity in Northern Anne Arundel County during an average month. Annually, the pantry distributes more than \$36,000 worth of groceries to our neighbors in need. They could not accomplish this work of charity without the partnership of the Anne Arundel County Food Bank and the generosity of the St. Philip Neri Parish community.

We are asking each house to donate the following items. This is completely voluntary. Many of these household and hygiene items can be found at Dollar General or Dollar Tree. Items should be sent to school with your child and will be collected in the school lobby from September 23 to October 18. Each house will have a bin to place the items.

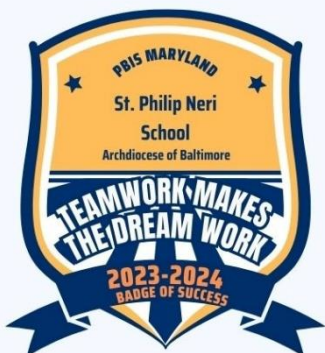

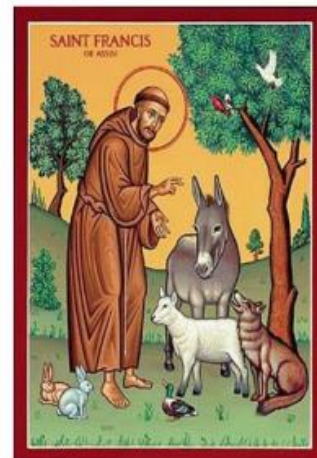
