
Our amazing band students wrapped up the school year with one last performance!

In preparation for Easter, our Pre-K classes learned about and reenacted Palm Sunday, washing of the feet, and the Last Supper.
























→ KB held their May Crowning as well! Andrew S. crowned the Blessed Mother while the other students presented flowers.












