

#### LUNCH ACCOUNTS & AUG/SEPT MENU -

We are excited to offer hot lunch 5 days a week. We will no longer participate in the AOB Child Nutrition school lunch program. Instead, lunches will be fully managed by the school. This change means we can offer more variety and options, though we are no longer able to provide free or reduced lunches. The cost of the lunches will be \$4.00. Currently we are asking families to send in a check or money order to the school cafeteria. We are hoping to get an on-line option available soon. Checks to be made to the "St. Philip Neri Lunch Program" in an envelope with your child's name and teacher's name on it. All money collected is added to the family account for meal/à la carte purchases. No money is collected in the serving line.

#### MEDICATION FORMS (REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS)

Medication Forms (for Over-the-Counter and Prescription Medications)

Please read the following information carefully, if your child needs an Over-the-Counter Medication or Prescription medication dispensed while at school:

#### Consent for Administration of Over-The-Counter Medications Form

The over-the-counter medication form and requirements changed last year. This form is required for any student requesting the administration of OTC medications. Over-the-counter medications listed on the Consent for Administration of Over-The-Counter Medications Form will be dispensed only if BOTH the medical provider and the parent/guardian sign and date the form. We will not dispense over-the-counter medication without the signed consent on file. Forms are available in the school office and attached to the Weekly Update.

The Maryland State School Medication Administration Authorization Form

If your child is to receive any over-the-counter medication that is NOT listed on the Consent for Administration of Over-The-Counter Medications Form, then please complete The Maryland State School Medication Administration Authorization Form, which is attached below. This form should also be used for prescription medications that need to be administered. A medical provider must sign/date this form.

Parents/guardians must hand deliver any over-the-counter and prescription medications directly to the Health Room. Over-the-counter medication must be brought to school in an original, unopened container and labeled with the student's name and homeroom. Students are not permitted to self-carry over-the-counter or prescription medications.
