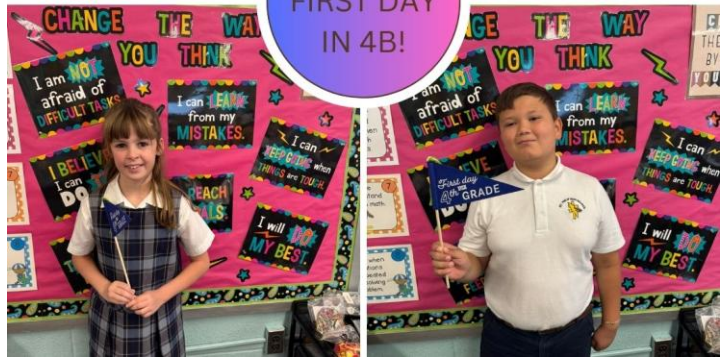

Little brother, Sean, was happy to be there to support his big sisters.



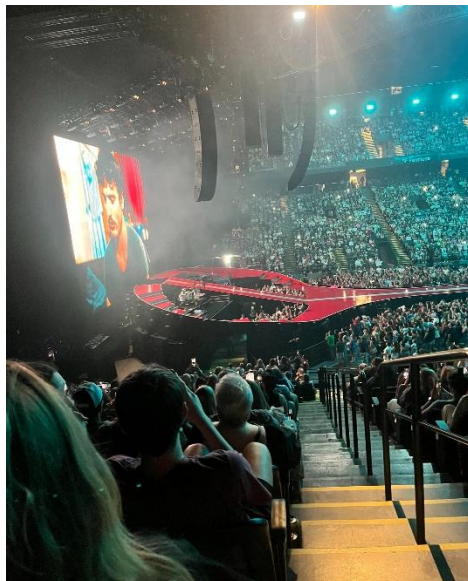

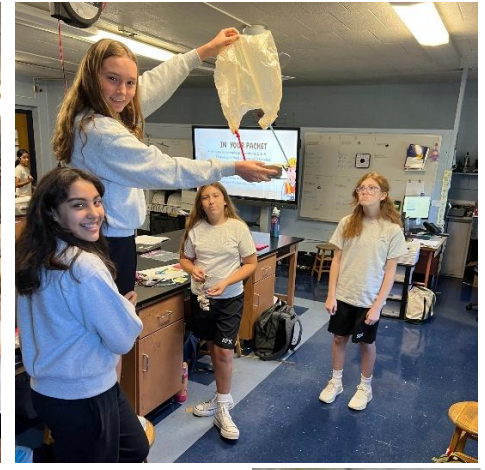
Ava and Lexi set up their own business over the weekend! They opened a lemonade stand and even Ms. Kaitlyn stopped by to support their local small business! →
