Our 5A class did 100 exercises at the 100th minute of the 100th day of school!

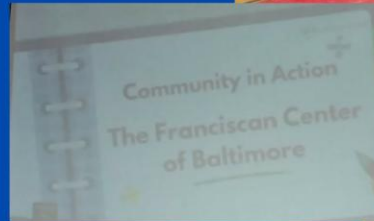




Spots, smiles, and lots of cuteness!

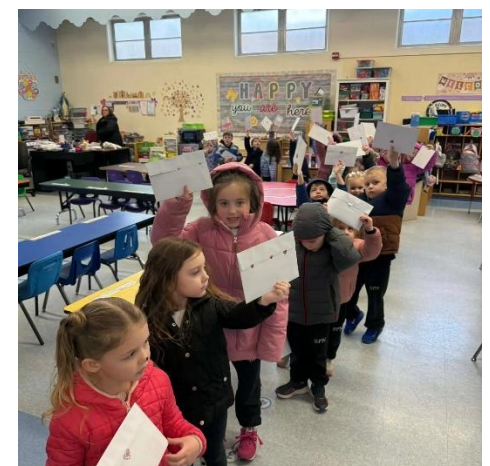

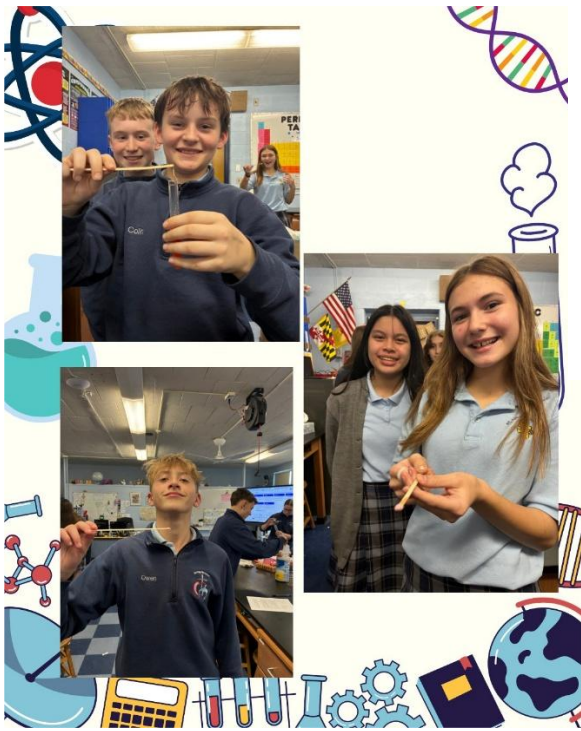

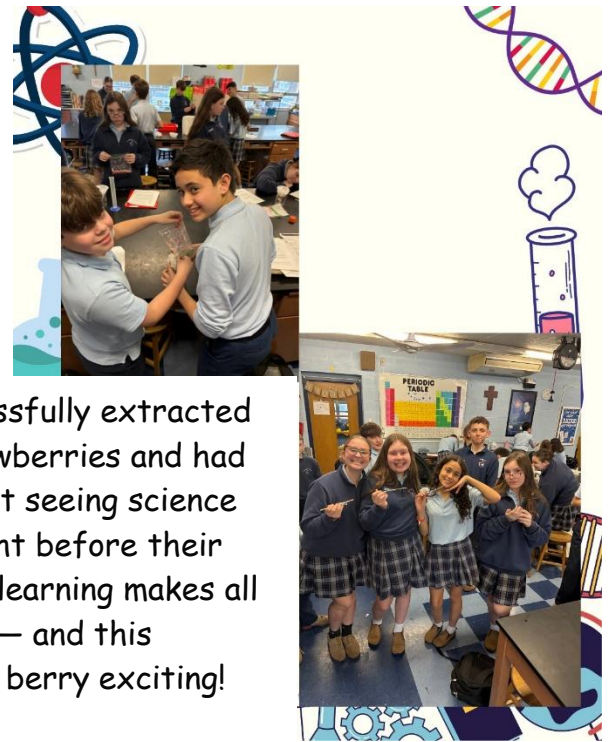


"Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." -
