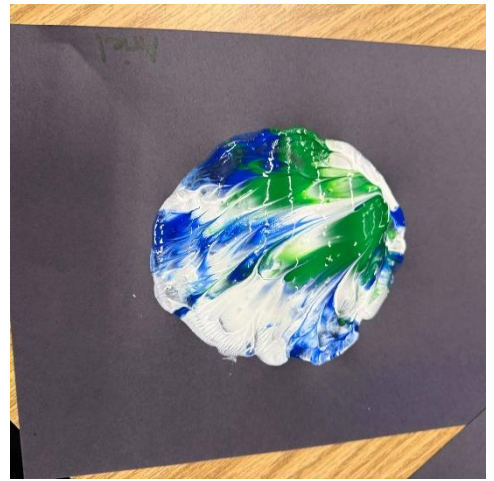
SPN Jesters Celebrate Earth Day! Our 3B class rolled up their sleeves for an Earth Day clean-up!

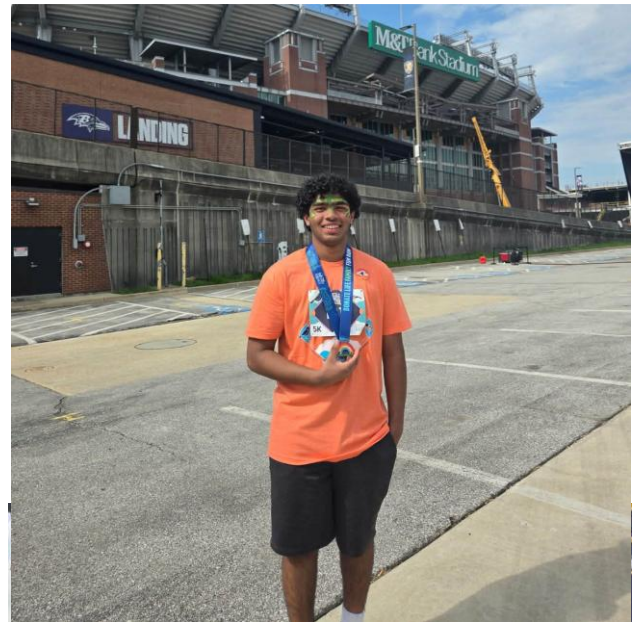

Some of our 8th grade cast and crew enjoyed lunch at Cane's in between shows. It's always nice to hang out with friends and make memories!

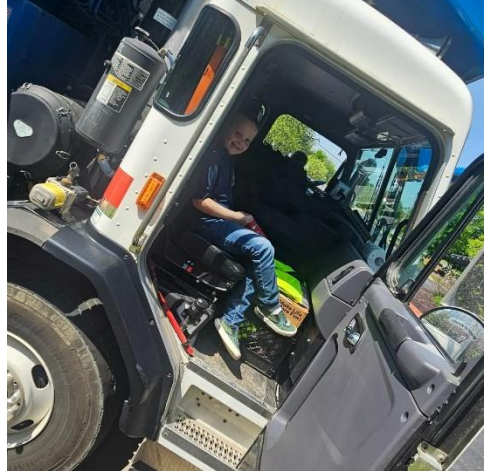
