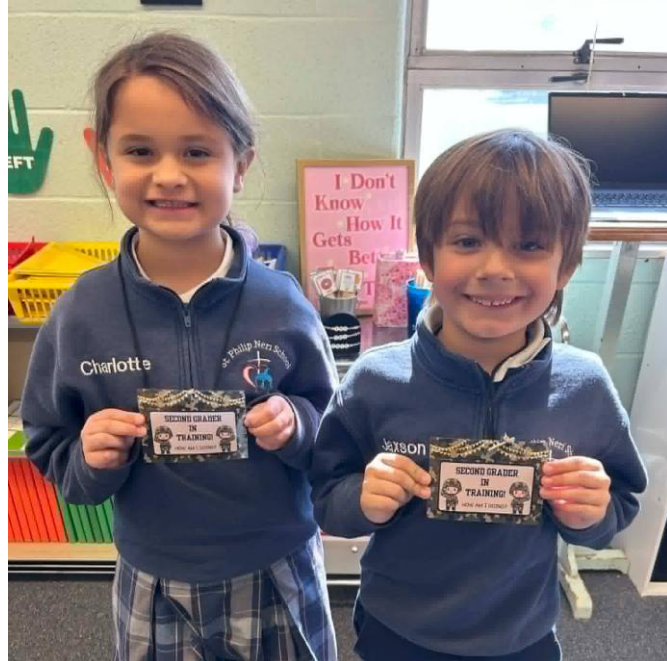
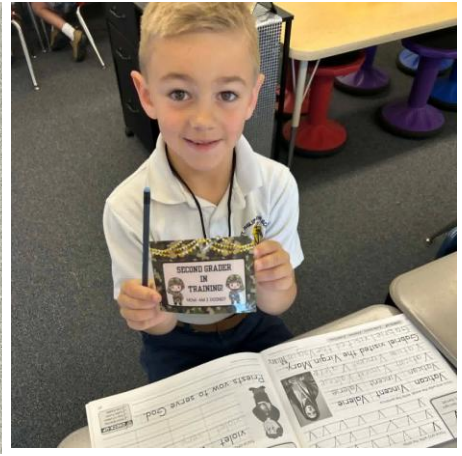
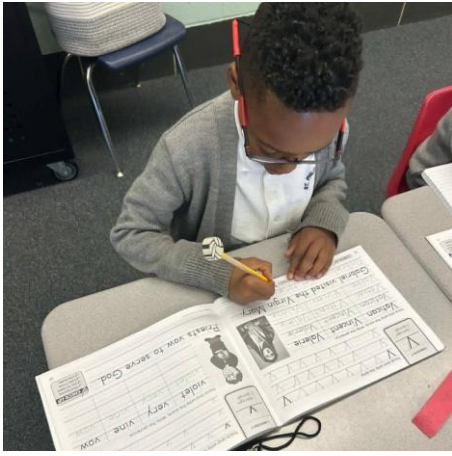


1B is officially full of published authors and illustrators!

We designed our book as a first-grade memory book, so now each student has a sweet keepsake to look back on and reflect on their year!

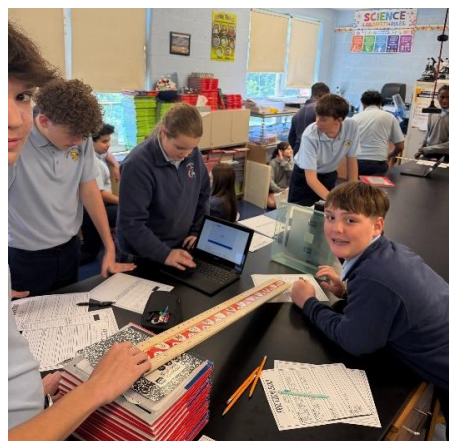
We are so proud of all their hard work—these kiddos truly poured their hearts into this project, and it shows!

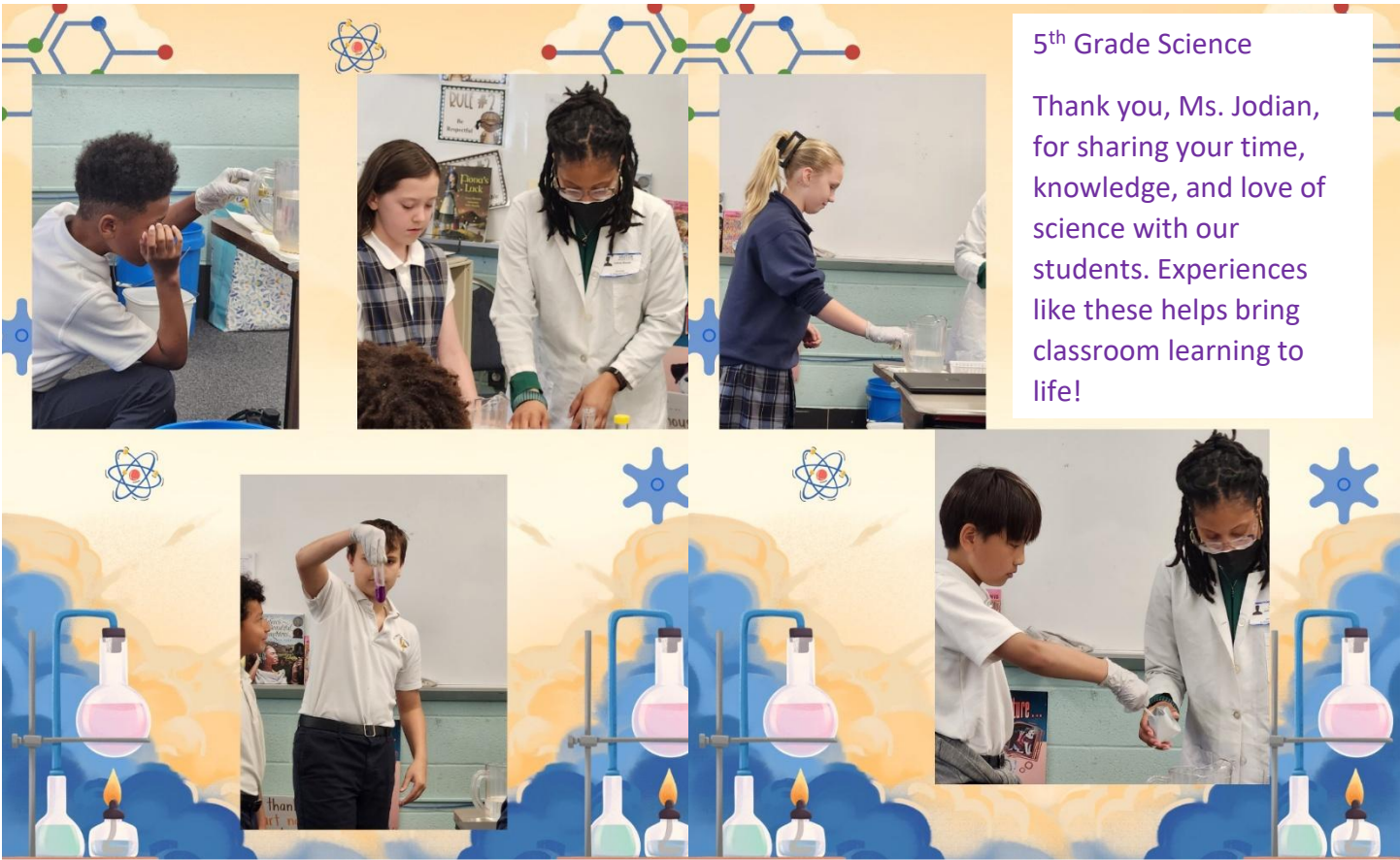




Our 5th grade scientists had an exciting hands-on learning experience!

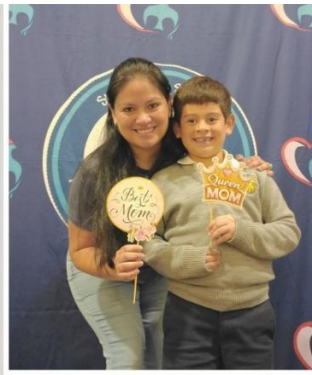

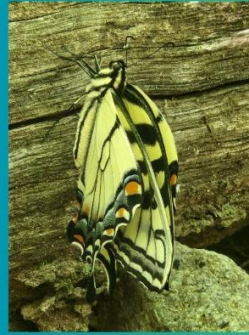
